

Bailey Given Prison Term

Jeff A Bailey, 20, Indianapolis, was sentenced to 15-25 years imprisonment Friday in Hancock Superior Court by Judge Richard T. Payne.

Bailey had pleaded guilty to second degree murder earlier in the week, after being charged with first degree murder in the death of a Marshall High School freshman, Robert Jackson, Jr., 15, Indianapolis.

Jackson's body was found

last Nov. 22 in Buck Creek south of Cumberland. Bailey was arrested in California in November on a traffic charge, and was identified as the suspect wanted in the Jackson slaying.

Arraignment of Charles Fleenor, Jr. charged with sale of dangerous drugs, was set for July 7 in Superior Court Friday. He is alleged to have sold marijuana on June 1.
