

Pleads Guilty In Boy's Death

GREENFIELD, Ind. (AP)—Jeffrey A. Bailey, 19, Indianapolis pleaded guilty in Hancock Superior Court here Monday to a reduced charge of manslaughter in the death of an Indianapolis teen-ager last November.

A pre-sentence investigation was ordered for Bailey who is charged in the death of Robert Jackson Jr., 15, a Marshall High School freshman. His body was found in 18 inches of water in a creek near Cumberland last Nov. 22.

Police said the boy had two handkerchiefs tied around his neck and his hands had been tied with boot strings.
