The following fines and sentences were imposed in Hancock Superior Court 2:

Nov. 10

John N. Wright, sentenced to two years in jail, all but 30 days suspended, two years alcohol and drug probation, alcohol and drug testing, one year suspended license, driving while intoxicated.

Mariland K. Guinn, sentenced to 180 days in jail, all but 30 days suspended, 180 days probation, public intoxication.

Carole A. Crain, fined \$613, sentenced to one year in jail, all but two days suspended, one year alcohol and drug probation, one year vehicle ignition interlock device, alcohol and drug testing, 90 hours community service, 30 days suspended license, 180 days restricted license, driving while intoxicated.
