

Masked Youth Takes \$70, Runs

An armed youth wearing blue jeans, a blue jacket and a green stocking mask held up the United Oil Station, 3510 S. Meridian, today.

The attendant, Dennis Hanna, 18, of 3229 Coffey, told sheriff's deputies the gunman, about 18, took \$70 in the 2 a.m. robbery.

Paul McDougall, 33, 1929 N. Parker, attendant at the Star service station, 502 W. 16th, told police he had to break a window to get out of a restroom after two men robbed that station about 6:45 a.m. yesterday.

McDougall told police the two had been in the station about two hours earlier in a car, and returned on foot, threatening him with a pistol and taking \$32 before locking him in the restroom.
