

Suspect In Kidnaping Of Newsboy Returned

A suspect in the Oct. 31 kidnaping of a 16-year-old newsboy has been returned to Indiana from California and will appear in Municipal Court, Room 10, today.

Larry W. Payton, 23, 500 block of South Harding Street, was arrested Nov. 24 by Los Angeles County police at the Sylmar (Calif.) home of his mother, Mrs. Helen Hague.

Payton, who had waived extradition, was brought back yesterday by Indianapolis police detectives Darryl S. Churchill and Robert Hoke.

Police said Payton, who is charged with kidnaping, is believed to be the man who lured a 16-year-old carrier of The Indianapolis Star into a car

near his Eastside home about 6:30 a.m. Oct. 31. The man is suspected of having driven the boy around Marion, Hancock and Madison counties for several hours and sexually assaulting him.
